The Bar and Weights must have been weighed before the competition or immediately after the Record Attempt. The Athletes costume and personal equipment must have been inspected and conform to the requirements of the GPC Rules. A minimum of Two GPC International Referees and One National Referee of a National Federation affiliated to the GPC are required to certify a World Record.

The Lifter and his/her Attire have been checked and conform to the requirements of the GPC Rules.
